The Annual fees prescribed for MBA (Day/Evening) & MCA Courses offered in **Bangalore University Department/CBSMS** for candidates seeking admission to MBA (Day/Evening) & MCA Courses for I year during 2025-26 and II year during 2026-27 are notified as under (2025-27 batch):

NOTE: 1) MBA (Day/Evening) & MCA students who have paid the fee at the time counseling at KEA are required to pay the difference amount. The SC/ST students whose family annual income is above 2.5 Lakhs are liable to pay the prescribed fee in full.

2)* Fees are not entitled for reimbursement from Social Welfare Department to SC/ST candidates.

(B) ELIGIBILITY FEES FOR ADMISSION TO I YEAR:

Indian Nationals who have passed the qualifying examination outside Karnataka shall pay the following **Eligibility Fees** to the University in addition to the regular fee as prescribed in the table given below:

Indian Nationals, Foreign Nationals and Non-Resident Indians who have passed the qualifying examination abroad (outside India) shall submit the Equivalence Certificate issued by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) along with the application to the University. The provisional Eligibility certificate will be issued on payment of the prescribed fee. The provisional Eligibility certificate shall be obtained prior to admission.

(D) FEES PRESCRIBED FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS & NRIs

The Foreign Nationals and NRIs shall pay US \$ 2200 as annual fees in addition to Eligibility fees for various courses during I year and US \$ 2200 during II year.

(E) ADMISSION WITHOUT PRE-PAYMENT OF COMPULSORY FEE FOR SC/ST STUDENTS & SUBSEQUENT FEE PAYMENT (BALANCE) PRIOR TO PAYMENT OF SECOND/FOURTH SEMESTER EXAMINATION FEE.

With effect from the year 2023-24, the Government of India in consultation with the Department of Education and the Department of Social Welfare, has directed that the students belonging to SC/ST category whose annual income of the family is less than Rs.2.5 Lakhs and are eligible for the post-metric scholarship, will be provided admission (excluding non reimbursable fee/deposit amount if any) without having to pay any compulsory fees at the time of admission subject to submission of Freeship card.

The SC/ST applicants who wish to claim fee concession/availing admission without Pre-payment of compulsory fees may be directed to submit the 'Scholarship sanctioned status of the previous year (2024-25)/ Freeship card of previous Academic year which can be downloaded from the student's login in the SSP Portal. Further, they may also be directed to submit a copy of the valid Income and Caste Certificate issued by the Tahsildar along with Scholarship sanctioned status.

However, the students who are seeking admission without pre-payment of compulsory fee to the following courses shall pay the fees which are not entitled for reimbursement from the Social Welfare Department i.e., Cultural activity (Rs.200/-), Student activity fee (Rs.100/-), User Fee (Rs.200/-).i.e.

I Year M.B.A-(Day) / MCA Rs. 500/-

II year M.B.A-(Day) / MCA Rs. 500/-

However, the above students shall submit the freeship card of this academic year (which can be downloaded from state scholarship Portal-SSP) to their respective University Department within 31-12-2025, failing which, they are liable for payment of balance Course fees.

The applicants who had not availed the scholarship in the previous year **are not eligible** to claim the fee concession/ without Pre-payment of compulsory fees at the time of admission and are liable to pay the prescribed fees in full. However, the eligible students can apply for scholarship in the SSP Portal for this academic year and get the reimbursement of compulsory fees from the sponsoring departments i.e., Social Welfare Department and Tribal Welfare Department.

The Director/ Co-Ordinator of Bangalore University Departments shall direct the SC/ST students (who have taken admission without pre-payment of compulsory fee of the respective course) to pay the Balance of course fee after received from the scholarship amount Social Welfare Department, Government of Karnataka, i.e., fees due to be paid at the time of admission, prior to payment of II & IV semester examination fee. **In case of non-receipt of course Fees reimbursement** for what so-ever reasons (non-submission/incomplete submission of scholarship application, submission of application

after due date, etc.) mentioned therein / short payment of fee reimbursement by the Social Welfare Department, **such students shall also be directed to pay the balance of course fees in full** (which was due to be paid at the time of admission), prior to payment of II & IV semester examination fee.

The original marks cards submitted by the student at the time of admission and /or other documents (PG examination marks card, Degree Certificate/PDC, TC etc.,) shall not be issued until the students clear all the dues to the University Department.

Students belonging to SC/ST category of other State and SC/ST students of Karnataka whose family annual income is above Rs.2.50 Lakhs shall pay full fees. SC/ST candidates seeking admission to second PG Course (PG discontinued are also taken into account) are not eligible for fee concession.

(F) Mode of Payment: (1) Selected students shall pay the above fees through online on Bangalore University Website: <https://bangaloreuniversity.karnataka.gov.in> and submit the copy of the receipt to the concerned department.

(G) REFUND AND FORFEITURE OF FEES

- (1) Candidate for any reason may cancel his/her seat by submitting the following documents;
- Original Provisional Admission Card
 - Original Fee Receipt
 - Application for cancellation of seat and refund of fee paid with clear & complete correspondence address with Bank details

And

- (2) Refund shall be considered as per clause 4.1.3 of the UGC Fee Refund Policy 2024-25 vide D.O. No.F.2-71/2022 (CPP-II) (C-114546) dated: 12th June 2024 4.1.3, the following tier system for the refund of fees* remitted by the student shall be followed:

(1)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission.
(2)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission.
